INSPIRED BY SERVICE DRIVEN BY PURPOSE

The quote above by Denzel Washington embodies the core beliefs my wife, Diane, and I share about life and service. With a strong desire to give back, we found our inspiration in 2017 through Wreaths

Across America, an annual observance held each December to honor fallen service members by placing wreaths on their graves. From that moment, we knew this was a cause we wanted to support, ensuring that no fallen soldier would be forgotten.

As previous members of Arrow Creek Country Club, we saw an opportunity to help by hosting a golf tournament to benefit Wreaths Across America. We approached the club with the idea, and they graciously agreed to host the event.

In the beginning, it was just the two of us, guided by a shared vision and supported by a small group of friends and family. Together, we planned the event, gathered raffle items, and collected modest donations. That first tournament was both uplifting and encouraging, allowing us to fund the purchase of 500 wreaths. In 2018, we were proud to double that impact.

We are committed to continue hosting the tournament, we continue to support Wreaths Across America by honoring the interred veterans at the Northern Nevada cemeteries. Each year, our efforts have grown. In 2020, we officially became a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, supported by more than 20 dedicated volunteers and friends who share our mission.

Our long-term goal is to provide sustainable funding for wreaths on 25% of the cemetery’s gravesites each year. Currently, there are more than 13,000 gravesites, a number that continues to grow. As we move forward and continue honoring our fallen heroes, we are often reminded of this powerful truth: “Our flag does not fly because the wind moves it... it flies with the last breath of each soldier who died protecting it.” — Anonymous


